WHAT DIFFERENCE DOES EASTER

(THE RESURRECTION) MAKE? Reference: Matthew 27:57–28:7

Easter (i.e. the resurrection) means two things:
ONE the resurrection means Jesus who He said He and remember Jesus claimed to be God!
There are only four possible options as to the identification of Jesus Christ:
the God of the Universe
Jesus Christ has three basic credentials to establish that He is who He claimed to be:
Credential one was his impact on The abbreviation AD represents the Latin words <i>Anno Domini</i> , which mean "in the year of our"
Credential two was his fulfillment of messianic
Messianic prophecies were prophecies (i.e. predictions) made in the Old Testament about the promised Jewish Messiah (Jesus) that would be born at the beginning of the New Testament. There are altogether some 60 different major messianic
prophecies that include some 333 Old Testament verses, and Jesus Christ fulfilled each one of those prophecies.

Through the resurrected Jesus our sins can be Forgiveness is possible because of a biblical doctrine called "substitution"
Definition: an innocent substitute is (punished or penalized) instead of the sinner so that God can then consider the sinner as innocent as the substitute
Reference: II Corinthians 5:21, "For He (God) made Him (Jesus) who knew no sin, to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness (goodness) of God in Him."
Through the resurrected Jesus our problems can be
Reference: Ephesians 1:19 and 20 verse nineteen , "and what is the exceeding greatness of His (God) power toward us who believe (Christians) according to the working of His (God) mighty power." verse twenty , "which He (God) worked (demonstrated) in Christ when He (God) raised Him (Jesus) from the dead…"
