<b>verse fourteen</b> , "For the kingdom of heaven is like a man traveling to a far country, who called his own servants and delivered <b>his goods</b> to them."					
These servant managers owned nothing; just as spiritual servant managers we own nothing.					
References: Job 41:11b, Psalm 24:1, Haggai 2:8, etc.					
Principle: we but God  Because God owns it all He can take it back if he chooses to do so.					
Reference: <b>Job 1:21b</b> , "the LORD gave and the LORD has taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD."

<b>verse fifteen</b> , "And to one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one, <b>to each according to his own ability</b> ; and immediately he went on a journey."					

The term talent is sometimes used in Scripture to refer to money but the word "talent" itself just represented a of In this case, the word "talent" represents not only money but also all that God has entrusted to us. (i.e. abilities opportunities, resources, etc.)

T represents A represents G represents spiritual
THREE is the principle of
<b>verse nineteen</b> , "After a long time the lord of these servants (the master) came and <b>settled accounts with them</b> ."
Reference: Romans 14:12, "So then each of us shall give account of himself to God."
There is a specific prophetical event that is designed to facilitate this accounting process, and that event is called the Judgment Seat of Christ.
