ESSENTIALS TO DISCIPLESHIP - Part Two

The Greek word translated as "disciple" (<i>mathetes</i>) is mentioned times in the Gospels (Matthew , Mark , Like and John) and then times in the book of Acts .
The word disciple means someone who receives instruction. In ancient times a disciple would attach himself to a rabbi (teacher) in order to gain practical or theoretical instruction and or experience. In modern times we would use the word "apprentice" to describe a disciple. If a disciple apprentice wanted to ultimately do what his rabbi did then two things had to happen: • He had to spend with the rabbi. • He had to become the rabbi. Reference: Luke 6:40 (see screen)
In a biblical sense someone becomes a disciple at salvation; so, a disciple is a Christian and a Christian is a disciple. Jesus is our rabbi and we are His disciples. But at salvation we are made a just beginning apprentice disciple and the ultimate objective is for us to become a more fully developed (Journeyman) disciple. That requires continued commitment and time. Reference: Acts 14:20b-21 (see screen)
Definition : A fully developed disciple (follower) of Jesus Christ is a Christian learner that is radically committed to both his(Jesus) and His
Remember, a disciple is a learner but a true disciple is much more than an average classroom student. An authentic disciple is a student committed to both from his teacher and then his teacher as much as possible.
Five Axioms of Discipleship:
NUMBER ONE is that disciples are and not born . Reference: Matthew 28:19 (see screen)
NUMBER TWO is that discipleship is a and not just a program.
