Reference: **Genesis 8:1-9:17**

The **Noahic covenant** is found in **Genesis 9:8-17** and has five fundamental components:

First...it's a \_\_\_\_\_ covenant (i.e. promise)  
**verse nine**, “*And as for Me, behold, I (God) **establish my covenant with you ...***”  
**verse seventeen**, “*And God said to Noah, ‘This is the sign of **the covenant which I have established...***”

This covenant is unilateral and that means it's a \_\_\_\_\_ person covenant. A bilateral covenant is a \_\_\_\_\_ person covenant

God made six different covenants throughout the Old Testament.

- 1) the **Noahic** covenant  
Reference: **Genesis 9:8-17**
- 2) the \_\_\_\_\_ covenant  
Reference: **Genesis 15:18-21**
- 3) the **Priestly** covenant  
Reference: **Numbers 25:10-13**
- 4) the \_\_\_\_\_ covenant.  
Reference: **II Samuel 7**
- 5) the **Mosaic** covenant  
Reference: **Exodus 19-24**
- 6) the \_\_\_\_\_ Covenant  
Reference: **Jeremiah 31:31 and 33**

Second...it is an \_\_\_\_\_ covenant.

There are 2 categories of divine covenants:

- Conditional covenants are covenants that God had made to man that go into effect only if man \_\_\_\_\_ certain conditions
- Unconditional covenants are covenants that God has made to man that go into effect \_\_\_\_\_ man meeting any conditions

Third...it was a covenant made to \_\_\_\_\_ and his \_\_\_\_\_ in addition to all that is alive

Reference: **Genesis 9:8-10**

**verse eight**, “*Then God spoke to Noah and to his sons with him, saying:”*

**verse nine**, “*And as for Me, behold, **I establish My covenant with you and with your descendants after you,***”

**verse ten**, “***and with every living creature that is with you: the birds, the cattle, and every beast of the earth with you, of all that go out of the ark, every beast of the earth,***”

Fourth...it was a covenant that ensured God would never again \_\_\_\_\_ a universal flood

**verse eleven**, “*thus I (God) **establish my covenant with you: never again shall all flesh be cut off by the waters of the flood; never again shall there be a flood to destroy the earth.***”

Fifth...it was a covenant sealed with a sign called the \_\_\_\_\_

God created a rainbow as a sign of his covenantal promise not to destroy the earth in another flood as an act of divine judgment

Reference: **Genesis 9:12-17**

**verse twelve**, “*And God said: ‘This is the sign of the covenant which I make between Me and you, and every living creature that is with you, for perpetual generations:’*”

**verse thirteen**, “*‘I set My rainbow in the cloud, and it shall be for the sign of the covenant between Me and the earth.’*”

**verse fourteen**, “*‘It shall be, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the rainbow shall be seen in the cloud’*”

**verse fifteen**, “*‘and I will remember My covenant which is between Me and you and every living creature of all flesh; the waters shall never again become a flood to destroy all flesh.’*”

**verse sixteen**, “*‘The rainbow shall be in the cloud, and I will look on it to remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that is on the earth.’*”

**verse seventeen**, “*And God said to Noah, ‘This is the sign of the covenant which I have established between Me and all flesh that is on the earth.’*”
