THE HOLY SPIRIT – Part X "So What Are You Full Of?" – Holy Spirit Filling Pt 3

Just as alcohol transforms someone into something that he was not before, so does the Holy Spirit. If someone is filled with the Holy Spirit, the Spirit then transforms that person in a supernatural sense. That transformation is manifested as visible changes in someone's attitude and actions. Some of those changes are mentioned in **Ephesians 5.**

ONEis a singing heart verse nineteen, "speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord."
TWO is a spirit verse twenty, "giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ."
It is important to distinguish between someone just being grateful and actual thankfulness.

Let's address four questions about being thankful from this particular verse.
Question One: are we to be grateful?
Answer: we are to be thankful "giving thanks always"
