## THE HOLY SPIRIT - Part IV

"What is this born again stuff about? Regeneration"
Reference: **John 3:1-10**Pastor Larry Webb

Just what is this born again stuff about? That's the question we want to answer in this message and we're going to answer that question from **John chapter three**.

<b>Question</b> : why does someone need to be born again (i.e. regenerated)? <b>Answer</b> : because we are born the first time (depraved).
PRINCIPLE: total depravity doesn't mean that man in his pre-salvation state is as as he could be (i.e. utter depravity); but, man in his pre-salvation condition is as as he could be (i.e. total depravity)
The Bible uses graphic language to describe man's spiritual condition before salvation:
Man has a heart (Jeremiah 17:9)
Man is under sin (Galatians 3:22)
Man is in a spiritual sense (Ephesians 2:1 and 5)
Man is condemned (John 3:36) Man is subject to (I John 5:19)
Man is lost (Luke chapter fifteen)
Man is in sin (Psalm 51:5) Man is a slave to sin (Romans 6:20)
Man cannot spiritual things (I Corinthians 2:14) Man is defiled from the inside out (Mark 7:21-23)
Man is defiled from the inside out (Mark 7:21-23)
Man is a of (potential) wrath (Ephesians 2:3)
Man falls short of divine perfection (Romans 3:23)
Jesus mentions a specific formula for regeneration in <b>verse five</b> "Jesus answered, 'Most assuredly I say to you, unless one is <b>born of water</b> and the <b>Spirit</b> , he cannot enter the kingdom of God.""
This is the formula: <b>Regeneration</b> (rebirth or spiritual birth) = + Holy Spirit
Three common opinions as to what this water means:
Onethis water is a reference to water
Two this water refers to the that surrounds the unborn fetus inside a mother's uterus
