"Get an eternal perspective" Reference: **Philippians 3:17-20** Pastor Larry Webb

There are two different role models mentioned in this section: from verse seventeen, the first example is a good one and describes Paul...the second and most unacceptable example is the Judaizers described in verses eighteen and nineteen.

verse seventeen, "Brethren, join in following my example..."

Reference: I Corinthians 11:1, "Imitate me, as I also imitate Christ."

verse seventeen continued, "...and note (or notice) those who so walk (conduct themselves) as you have us for a pattern."

Those ancient false teachers called Judaizers were the second example cited in this text and were referred to as enemies of the cross.

verse eighteen, "For many walk (conduct themselves) of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ."

Paul mentions, in verse nineteen, four basic characteristics of those that are considered enemies of the cross...

- "whose end is destruction..."
- "whose god is their belly..."
- "and whose glory is in their shame..."
- "who set their mind on earthly things..."

verse twenty, "For our **citizenship** is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ."

Reference: I Peter 2:11, "Beloved, I beg you as sojourners and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul."
