verse seven, "but make Himself of no reputation."

The word "reputation" is translated from the Greek word "kenoo:" from which we get kenosis" meaning "to make empty... to deprive of possessions and properties."

That's the reason this section is called the Kenosis passage because it describes how Jesus emptied himself in becoming a man.

Paul mentions five different things that Jesus did in conducting this kenosis

ONE... "taking the form of a bondservant verse seven (cont'd)

TWO... "and coming in the likeness of men." verse seven (cont'd)

> Reference: I Timothy 3:16a, "And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness; God was manifest in the flesh..." (i.e. the incarnation)

THREE... "and being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself." verse eight

FOUR... "and became obedient to the point of death" verse eight (cont'd)

FIVE... "even the death of the cross." verse eight (cont'd)

Because Jesus went through the kenosis process God has

honored him. verse nine, "Therefore God also has highly exalted Him."

F	Being humble (humility) results in Reference: Proverbs 15:33b, Solomon said, " before honor is humility."
